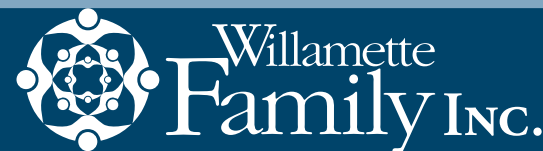

WHAT IS MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)?

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) is the use of medications, in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, to provide a "whole-patient" approach to the treatment of substance use disorders. Medications used in MAT are approved by the Federal Drug Administration, and MAT programs are clinically driven and tailored to meet each patient's needs.

OPIOID USE TREATMENT

Willamette Family provides office-based opioid treatment for all clients. Services and supports include:

- » Medication
 - » Buprenorphine (i.e. Subutex)
 - » Naltrexone (i.e. Vivitrol)
 - » Buprenorphine/Naloxone (i.e. Suboxone)
- » Behavioral Health Treatment Groups offered
 - Groups specific to medication-assisted treatment patients offered at residential, day treatment, intensive outpatient and outpatient programs.
- » Recovery Supports and Wrap-Around Services
- » Peer-led prosocial activities for MAT patients
- » 24-hour Peer Support WarmLine, available for MAT patients to call at any time
- » Recovery supports regularly offered by WF, including parenting support, transportation, and housing assistance and referrals, and more.

RESCUE MEDICATION

Providing rescue medication is an important harm reduction tool that can save lives! Willamette Family's no-barrier service is open to the public, and provides Naloxone nasal spray (NARCAN) for free.

Anyone is welcome to visit the Health Clinic and request rescue medication from the receptionist. No prescription or appointment needed, and no questions asked.

TOBACCO CESSATION

Willamette Family provides and encourages clients' tobacco cessation goals. Medication and additional services include:

- » Medication including nicotine patches, gum, and lozenges
- » Tobacco Cessation education
- » Client incentives for tobacco cessation
