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# WHAT IS MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)?

Medication Assisted Treatment(MAT) is the use of medications, incombination with counseling andbehavioral therapies, to provide a"whole-patient" approach to thetreatment of substance usedisorders. Medications used inMAT are approved by the FederalDrug Administration, and MATprograms are clinically driven andtailored to meet each patient'sneeds.

### **OPIOID USE TREATMENT**

Willamette Family provides office-based opioid treament for all clients. Services and supports include:

- » Medication
  - » Buprenorphine (i.e. Subutex)
  - » Naltrexone (i.e. Vivitrol)
  - » Buprenorphine/Naloxone (i.e. Suboxone)
- » Behavioral Health Treatment Groups offered Groups specific to medication-assistedtreatment patients offered at residential, daytreatment, intensive outpatient and outpatientprograms.
- » Recovery Supports and Wrap-Around Services
- » Peer-led prosocial activities for MAT patients
- » 24-hour Peer Support WarmLine, available for MAT patients to call at any time
- » Recovery supports regularly offered by WF, including parenting support, transportation, and housing assistance and referrals, and more.

### **RESCUE MEDICATION**

Providing rescue medication is an important harm reduction tool that can save lives! Willamette Family's no-barrier service is open to the public, and provides Naloxone nasal spray (NARCAN) for free.

Anyone is welcome to visit the Health Clinic and request rescue medication from the receptionist. No prescription or appointment needed, and no questions asked.

#### **TOBACCO CESSATION**

Willamette Family provides and encourages clients' tobacco cessation goals. Medication and additional services include:

- » Medication including nicotine patches, gum, and lozenges
- » Tobacco Cessation education
- » Client incentives for tobacco cessation
